Faculty of Law and Political Sciences

Our work is carried out in a spirit of community: the university is a fellowship of students and lecturers who work together harmoniously. Through collective reflection, we aim to identify and offer solutions to the serious contemporary issues that threaten human dignity. Pázmány professors are influential legal scholars and passionate educators. We aspire to nurture intellectuals who are committed to serving both individuals and broader communities, while also developing their own talents to the fullest. We explore and teach how the legal system can support individuals and communities in cultivating their own unique set of values.

LAW (INTEGRATED SINGLE-CYCLE PROGRAMME) (HELD IN HUNGARIAN)

This five-year, integrated, university-level programme leads to a Master of Arts (MA) degree in Law. It provides comprehensive preparation for the legal profession, with its roots in ancient European legal traditions, particularly those of the Roman Empire. A law degree provides a broad education in the humanities that can be applied across a wide range of professional fields.

Beyond traditional legal careers, such as those of judges, prosecutors, or attorneys, this qualification opens doors to diverse professional paths with promising opportunities for advancement and personal growth. Graduates may, for example, lead their business ventures, work in the media, specialize in data protection in either the public or private sector, or serve in diplomatic roles, for example.

BA IN JUDICIAL ADMINISTRATION (HELD IN HUNGARIAN)

This six-semester undergraduate programme provides professional training in judicial organization. Judicial administrators are practical professionals who primarily support the decision-making processes within the justice system. Their responsibilities include assisting with the preparation and implementation of judicial decisions.

Most graduates pursue careers as court clerks, judicial or enforcement administrators, or court officers. Others find employment in various areas of public administration, including social services, land and property registry, or tax administration.

MASTER OF BUSINESS ADMINISTRATION (MBA) (HELD IN HUNGARIAN)

The MBA is a postgraduate programme designed to prepare students for leadership roles in business. The first MBA programme was established at Harvard University in 1908. Today, MBA programmes target individuals who already hold a bachelor's degree and have relevant work experience, but wish to deepen their business knowledge and leadership skills.

This qualification primarily provides access to a wide range of business management and executive positions.

POSTGRADUATE EDUCATION (HELD IN ENGLISH)



STIPENDIUM HUNGARICUM (SH)

State-funded scholarship opportunity for students from more than 90 partner countries to study in Hungary.



SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAMME FOR CHRISTIAN YOUNG PEOPLE (SCYP)

Designed for young Christians from crisis regions or countries where they face religious persecution, offering them educational opportunities in Hungary.



HUNGARIAN DIASPORA SCHOLARSHIP (HDS)

Aimed at individuals of Hungarian descent and roots, living abroad, this scholarship helps them reconnect with their heritage through education in Hungary.

Erasmus+ KA131

Types of rooms: four-bed room: 1; triple room: 33; double room: 31

Dormitory fee: HUF 40.000/month

One dormitory apartment can accommodate 5 people. The apartment consists of a hall-kitchen, a bathroom, a separate toilet and 2 rooms (one for 3 persons and one for 2 persons). The kitchen is equipped with a sink and a fridge. Each apartment also has a shared clothes dryer. Each room has a wardrobe, a wall shelf and a desk with a chair.

Community rooms: kitchen, laundry, study room, lecture room


Outdoor facilities: bike rack, bike storage, picnic tables

Number of spaces: 116

Rooms range from 1 to 4 people, and are arranged in apartments of 2-4 people. Each apartment has a kitchen with a fridge and a stove and a bathroom with its own washing machine.

Dormitory fee: HUF 40.000/month for a 3-4 bed room, HUF 75.000/month for a 2 bed room, and HUF 105.000/month for a single room.

Shared facilities: study room (The rooms here are equipped with a separate kitchen and washing machine.)
