Who can apply?

Individual researchers (PhD and master's level) or groups are eligible to lead projects. Research teams can include community partners, graduate researchers, or graduate and undergraduate students with the guidance of a professor or researcher. We welcome both new and ongoing SL projects, as long as they have not been published.

What is the timeline?

- Call for papers: We are accepting submissions **from March 1st until May 31st, 2025**. Please send your application forms and supporting documents by 24:00 (CET) May 31st 2025 by filling the [form](#).
- Papers review: The Jury will review received papers from **June 1st, 2025, until June 30th, 2025**.
- Final decisions announcement- **July 1st, 2025**.
- Implementation of the research project should take place between **September 1st, 2025, and August 31st, 2026**.
- Final report's deadline: **September 30th, 2026**.

What is the budget?

Uniservitate will allocate the sum of € 10,000 for all the applications within our region. We expect each application to not exceed **€ 2,000**. If your research requires a larger amount of funding, please provide a detailed justification in the application form.
